Introduction

We strive to collect and use visitor information responsibly and in alignment with our website Terms and Conditions. This Privacy Policy outlines the types of information we gather, how we use it, and the measures we take to secure and protect it.

Consent

By using fusionchristianacademy.ca, you consent to our Privacy Policy and agree to its Terms and Conditions.

Limitations of Use

This Privacy Policy applies only to our online activities and is valid for visitors to our website regarding the information shared or collected on fusionchristianacademy.ca. It does not apply to information collected offline or through channels other than this website.

Log Files

fusionchristianacademy.ca follows a standard procedure of using log files. These files log visitors when they visit websites. All hosting companies do this as part of their analytics services. The information collected by log files includes IP addresses, device and browser type, Internet Service Provider (ISP), date and time stamps, referring/exit pages, and user actions such as pages visited and clicks completed. This information is not personally identifiable and is used for administering the site, tracking users' movements and actions, quantifying site performance metrics, and analysing user data trends.

Cookies

Like many other websites, fusionchristianacademy.ca uses cookies. Cookies are small pieces of data sent to your browser by a website you visit. They help websites remember information about your visit, making the site easier to navigate and more

Google Analytics

This service, provided by Google Inc., collects information anonymously, such as the number of visitors, their location, the type of browser and operating system used, the date, time and duration of visits, and the pages viewed. Our use of Google Analytics may include the Demographics and Interest Reporting component. You can opt out of Google Analytics by installing the Google Analytics opt-out browser add-on or configuring your browser settings to block cookies.
